Format: <u>Modified Scramble</u> – Kids will tee off on the holes highlighted in **GREEN*** and Parents will tee off on the holes highlighted in **YELLOW***, the remaining holes will be played as normal scramble.

*the rest of the hole will be played as normal scramble.

Scorecards: Scorecards will be distributed at the starting tee. Please report the scoring area immediately after completion of play.

Golf Carts: Golf Carts are included in the registration fee. Carts will be available 15 minutes before your round starts, and they will have to return after the completion of the round

Players must place their ball within one club length of the shot selected, no nearer to the hole. Players' ball must remain in the same condition as the shot selected, i.e. fairway, rough, or sand. Play is governed by the Rules of Golf and Decisions, the US Kids Golf Foundation Rules and Regulations, and by the Local Rules.

STONES IN BUNKERS: Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions and may be moved without penalty (Rule 15.1 applies).

DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES: A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play (e.g., slope, elevation change, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4.3a(1). Penalty for first breach of Rule is two strokes and any subsequent offense is disqualification (score of 10 on any hole used).
