Van Horn Cup

7:30 a.m. | Sunday, August 4 | Pinehurst No. 4

Following the three-day championship, the top 20 boys and 12 girls from the 12-year-old age group are selected to play in the Van Horn Cup, a one-day best ball tournament contested on Pinehurst No. 4.

Van Horn Cup participants will be selected based on their score after 36 holes (Round 2). Once 36-hole scores are compiled, the Van Horn Cup selections and an alternate list will be published. Selected players will receive a special Van Horn Cup bag, shirt, hat, and caddie bib patch for the competition.


Awards will be presented to the winners of each match. The Van Horn Cup trophy will be presented to the winning team after the event. Additionally, the boys and girls pairing with the lowest rounds in the Van Horn Cup are awarded the Morrison Medal, named in honor of the late Sir Garth Morrison, who was Lord Lieutenant for East Lothian, and his wife Lady Gill Morrison.

Caddie Tip

A caddie is one who assists the player in accordance with rules, which may include carrying or handling the player's clubs during play.

Rule 10.2b:

» When a player begins taking their stance for the stroke that the player is about to play and until the stroke is made: The caddie must not deliberately stand on or close to an "extension of the player's line of play" behind the player's ball for any reason.

Pace of Play Tips

- » Caddies should not over-coach.
- » All players should play ready golf.
- » Players and caddies should walk with a purpose between shots.
- » Know your group's time par and position on the course.
- » When in doubt of a ruling, play a second ball under Rule 20.1. (Players must declare their intention to play a second ball BEFORE playing their original ball) Play a provisional ball if you think a player's ball may be lost outside a penalty hour or may be out of bounds.
- » Be mindful of how your pace of play affects your fellow competitors.
