Player Registration*

Check-in will take place at PGA Golf Club's Ryder Pavilion at the times listed below. Players only need to attend one of the registration periods.

Friday: 1:00pm to 4:00pm

Saturday: 7:00am to 12:00pm

Tournament Information and use of Cell Phones

All tournament information (Local Rules, Hole Locations, Tee Sheets, etc.) will be made available online. At starting tees, players will only receive scorecards. There will be no other paper information handed out. Players and caddies will be permitted to use their cell phones to access the information during their rounds. Cell phones may only be used during the round to access tournament info, call the rules hotline, access GPS yardage apps, or in the case of emergency. Cell phones may not be used for any other purpose.

Golf Genius

Boys 11, Boys 12, Boys 13-14 and Girls 13-14 on the Wanamaker Course utilize electronic live scoring via the Golf Genius App. Your online scorecard will serve as your official scorecard this week. More information, including your unique GGID, will be emailed to competitors soon. GGID for these age groups will be available at the player's starting hole as well. We advise players in these age groups to download the Golf Genius App before arriving to Port St. Lucie and to come to each round with their phones fully charged. The use of Golf Genius allows scores to be updated in real time on uskidsgolf.com, so parents, spectators, and supporters can keep up with the action. All other age groups will use paper scorecards.

Caddie Bibs

Players receive a universal U.S. Kids Golf Caddie Bib that they will keep and use for all future U.S. Kids Golf events. Additionally, an iron-on patch with the tournament logo will be available at every Major Championship. These patches will be available for no charge, and are designed to be worn as "pride stickers" for each event played.

If you have already received a Caddie Bib, please remember to bring it with you to the event.

Players that have preordered his/her last name will be able to pick up the name and caddie bib at Player Registration.

Dress Code

Only acceptable golf attire is permitted. PLAYERS AND CADDIES are prohibited from wearing shoes with metal spikes, short shorts, swimwear, denim of any kind, t-shirts, or tank tops. Shirts must be always tucked in. Players and caddies not appropriately attired will not be permitted to participate.

REQUIRED DRESS AT THE GOLF COURSE:

- Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward
- Males must remove hat/visor while indoors
- Shirts must be always tucked in
- Girls' fitted shirts do not have to be tucked in, but should be an appropriate length
- Shorts, skorts and skirts must be appropriate length

PROHIBITED DRESS AT THE GOLF COURSE:

- Tank tops, T-shirts
- Denim
- Cut-off shorts
- Gym shorts/pants

Proper attire is required at all times at the host facility. This includes practice rounds, Family Nights and Awards Ceremonies. Questionable attire will be reviewed by the Tournament Committee. Should a host golf course or resort have a stricter dress code, its policy will take precedence. Players and caddies in violation will not be allowed to tee off.

Care for the Course

U.S. Kids Golf is committed to keeping our host tournament sites in the best condition possible. During the round, we encourage players and caddies to fill or replace their divots, repair ball marks and dispose of trash properly. These simple things will keep the course in better condition and leave the host facility with a positive impression of junior golf and U.S. Kids Golf families. Thank you for helping make a positive impact on the golf course.

U.S. Kids Golf Text Messages

Throughout the 2025 PGA Golf Club Invitational, parents will receive important event updates via text message. The messages will include tee time updates, results, and potential play suspensions due to weather. Texts will be sent to your player's cell phone number listed in your profile.

U.S. Kids Golf Demo Day & Swing Speed Assessments

During the Practice Round on Friday, October 10th, players will be able to test out new U.S. Kids Golf equipment at the PGA Golf Club practice facility. The event will be held at the PGA Golf Club Practice Range from 9am – 4pm. Swing Speed Assessments with TrackMan are by appointment only and are currently sold out. All players are welcome to come demo the equipment.

Cart Rentals

Spectator carts are available at **1 cart maximum per player**, and may be rented no earlier than 30 minutes prior to your player's tee time. If a cart is rented for a 9-hole caddie, a spectator may ride with the caddie, but no additional carts may be rented for that player.

Spectator carts for 18-hole players may be rented for \$32, and \$20 for 9-hole players. All carts must be immediately returned following your player's round. All spectator carts are permitted to have no more than two passengers riding at any given time and must adhere to the [U.S. Kids Golf Cart Policy](#). Driver must have a valid Driver's License to operate the golf cart. Please be aware that the course has a limited number of golf carts available to rent.

Caddie Use of Carts

18-hole players and caddies may not use carts for play at any U.S. Kids Golf Regional Championship. All 18-hole players and caddies must walk during play of each hole at all events. Penalty: Two strokes per hole at which any breach occurred; Maximum penalty per round: Four strokes.

9-hole players' caddies may rent a cart for use during play; however the player must walk the duration of the hole and may **only** use the cart to be shuttled from green to the next tee box. The caddie may leave the bag on the cart or carry it on the course for the player when needed. Penalty: Two strokes per hole at which any breach occurred; Maximum penalty per round: Four strokes.

Practice Rounds

The Official Practice Round Fee for Friday, October 10th is included in your entry fee. You are able to book your tee time for the Official Practice Round online at the link here: [Practice Round Instructions](#). Please do not call the pro shop to book times for Friday. Players will still be able to book times any day prior to Friday by calling the pro shop. Practice round fees do not include carts. Carts will be available for an added cost (\$32/18 or \$20/9). You can adjust your tee time online up until Thursday at 12pm. All players must check in with the pro shop prior to your practice round.

PGA Merchandise Cards

Players will receive a \$25 Gift Card at Registration that can be redeemed at PGA Golf Club for Food & Beverage, or in the PGA Golf Club Pro Shop.

Tee Times

Players will be paired randomly the first round and by score for the final round, unless weather conditions prohibit this. Tee times for the first round will be posted on our website, at registration and around the PGA Golf Club by Thursday, October 9th.

Times for the final round will be posted on our website and at the golf course approximately one hour after the completion of play for each age/gender division. Players and parents are advised to look at pairings sheets personally to assure accuracy of tee times.

Junior Golf Scoreboard

U.S. Kids Golf will report PGA Golf Club Invitational scores to [Junior Golf Scoreboard](#) for boys 11 and older and girls 11 and older. Junior Golf Scoreboard is a ranking system that groups players by high school graduation year.



AJGA Performance Based Entry

Champions in Boys 11, Boys 12, Boys 13-14, Girls 11, Girls 12 and Girls 13-14 divisions will earn **two** AJGA Performance Stars. Top 5 in Boys 11, Boys 12 and Boys 13-14 will earn **one** Performance Star. Top 3 in Girls 11, Girls 12 and Girls 13-14 will also receive **one** Performance Star.



Priority Status

When your young player participates in U.S. Kids Golf events, they have the opportunity to earn [Priority Status](#) – a qualification that determines when players receive invitations for multi-day events.
