Carya Golf – Local Rules

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf, U.S. Kids Golf Rules and Regulations, and the following Local Rules:

PREFERRED LIES RULE A ball lying on any closely mown area in the General Area may, without penalty, be lifted, cleaned and placed within **one club length** of where it originally lay, not nearer the hole and not in a penalty area or on a putting green. A player may place the ball only once and after the ball has been placed it is in play.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS) (Rule 16)

- Heather areas are defined as GUR. If a ball is in a heather area, the ball may be dropped in accordance with Rule 16-1b (Abnormal Ground Conditions).
- Ice plant beds are integral parts of the course and free relief is **not** available.
- If the ball is in an area marked by blue stakes or areas painted as G.U.R (white paint, white dots), the ball may be dropped in accordance with Rule 16-1b (Abnormal Ground Conditions)
- All artificially surfaced buggy paths (trimmed bushes adjacent to the cart paths are part of the same obstruction), irrigation units and hydrant boxes, all course furniture and lighting units are immovable obstructions.
Players **cannot** get free drops from a lighting unit just because it is on the line of play. Player's stance or intended swing area must be interfering with the lighting unit to get a free drop.

DROP ZONES (E1.1)

If a player's ball has not been found and it is *known or virtually certain* that the ball came to rest in a *penalty area* on hole 6, the player may proceed under *Rule 17-1d*; or as an additional option, drop a ball, under **one penalty stroke**, in the dropping zone.

PROTECTION OF ORANGE TREES (E-10.1)

Orange trees are *no play zones*. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the *course* and it lies on or touches an orange tree or an orange tree interferes with the player's area of intended *stance* or area of intended swing, the player **must** take relief by dropping a ball under *Rule 16.1f*.

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: **General Penalty** Under Rule 14.7a.

UNSIGNED SCORECARDS (MLR L1): In the event a player returns their scorecard without player or marker certification, the penalty will be two strokes.
