

Final Results Girls 8 & 9

Going into the final day of the World Championships, the field is always split into two waves. The top 50% and ties go into Wave A, and the remaining players into Wave B. We do this in case the weather forces us to not be able to complete the final round due to afternoon storms, which frequently occur this time of year.

If inclement weather does not occur and all players finish, the results will be posted as normal.

However, if the Championship is not played to completion, then Wave A and Wave B are considered separate tournaments.

For example, in Girls 8 & 9, all players in Wave A completed play, and the results reflected a 27-hole champion. You will see this on the results page of our website marked Girls 8A and Girls 9A. For Wave B, marked Girls 8B and Girls 9B, all the players could only complete five holes. Following our Rules & Regulations, this counts as a Stipulated Round and counts towards 23-hole results for Wave B.

Please refer to the World Championships inclement weather and stipulated rounds policy below.

<u>Final Round Inclement Weather Policy</u>: If inclement weather forces us to shorten play, the tournament will be considered complete if all players in Wave 1 complete a 9 or 18-hole stipulated round in accordance with the World Championships Rules & Regulations. All players in Wave 2 must be able to finish all holes for Wave 2's Final Round scores to count towards the event.

Stipulated Rounds: When necessary to shorten an event, the round for all players will consist of two stipulated rounds. 9-hole competitors' rounds will consist of one 5-hole and one 4-hole stipulated round, and 18-hole competitors' rounds will consist of two 9-hole stipulated rounds. If an age group utilizes split tees and the final round is reduced, the age group will be split into A and B flights. Only the players in the A flight will be eligible to win the championship. Ranking information for Junior Golf Scoreboard and AJGA PBE will be submitted based on their respective stipulated round policies.
