

## Final Results Boys 9, 10, 11, 12 Girls 11, 12

Going into the final day of the World Championships, the field is always split into two waves. The top 50% and ties go into Wave A, and the remaining players into Wave B. We do this in case the weather forces us to not be able to complete the final round due to afternoon storms, which frequently occur this time of year.

If inclement weather does not occur and all players finish, the results will be posted as normal.

However, if the Championship is not played to completion, then Wave A and Wave B are considered separate tournaments.

For example, in Boys 12 this year, all players in Wave A completed play, and the results reflected a 54-hole champion. You will see this on the results page of our website marked Boys 12 A. For Wave B, marked Boys 12 B, all the players could not finish, and the scores were incomplete and reverted to 36 holes.

Please refer to the World Championships inclement weather policy below.

Final Round Inclement Weather Policy: If inclement weather forces us to shorten play, the tournament will be considered complete if all players in Wave 1 complete a 9 or 18-hole stipulated round in accordance with the World Championships Rules & Regulations. All players in Wave 2 must be able to finish all holes for Wave 2's Final Round scores to count towards the event.
