2018 U.S. Kids Golf Seaview Open Local Rules – Bay Course

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the U.S. Kids Golf Regional Championship Rules & Regulations, and the following Local Rules where applicable:

- 1. **Tournament/Rules Hotline** If, during your round, you need a ruling or rules official assistance, please call the tournament rules hotline at **910-420-0382**. Cell phones may only be used by a player or caddie to contact the rules hotline or in emergency situations, use of cell phones/apps as a distance-measuring device/GPS is prohibited.
- Lift, Clean and Place a ball lying on a closely mown area (your own fairway) through the green may be lifted and cleaned. Before lifting the ball, the player must mark its position. Having lifted the ball, the player must place it on a spot within 1 clublength and no closer to the hole than where it originally lay, that is not in a hazard or on a putting green. A player may place the ball only once, and it is in play once placed and at rest.
- 3. Seaview's native grass rule as defined on the course scorecard is **NOT IN EFFECT**. A lost ball in the native grass, not marked by red paint or red hazard stake, will be treated as a lost ball. **Please play a provisional ball if it's possible that your ball entered the native grass. The player must announce his/her intention to play a provisional ball.**
- 4. As an additional option, a drop zone marked "USKG DZ" is available on Hole #2.
- 5. The Ten Shot Rule applies to **9-hole age groups only**.
- 6. Relief is granted from all cart paths, including sand and gravel paths, and extensions of cart paths; nearest point of relief and one club-length, no closer to the hole, no penalty.
- 7. Retention walls in bunkers are deemed immovable obstructions.
- 8. All flower beds are deemed ground under repair and free relief is mandatory
- 9. All stones/seashells in bunkers are to be played as movable obstructions.
