ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES (ALR)

In addition to the local rules on the US Kids Golf Championship hard card, the following additional local rules shall apply.
PENALTY FOR BREACH OF A LOCAL RULE **General Penalty (2 strokes)**

1. Out of Bounds and Course Boundaries (Rule 18.2)

- 1a) A ball is out of bounds when it is beyond any wall, fence, white stakes/lines/dots.
- 1b) The clubhouse, driving range, practice greens and its surroundings.
- 1c) Hotel and maintenance buildings.
- 1d) Plant & Machinery Compound surround by Hole 6, Hole 7 & Hole 8 of Garden Course is defined by the edge of the fence.
- 1e) When the boundary edges are defined by wall, fence or lines / dots, the white stakes used to show the boundary edges are boundary objects
- 1f) Left of Hole 11. (The white stakes on the right of hole #3 is to be ignored, when playing hole #3).

2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

- 2a) Unless it is marked, the water side edges of the concrete retaining wall define the edges of the Penalty Area.
- 2b) Drop Zones for Hole 2, 11, 13, 18 are additional options when the ball is in the Penalty Areas of the hole in play.

3. Abnormal Course Conditions (including Immovable Obstructions) (Rule 16.1)

- 3a) Ground Under Repair
 - i. Newly turfed areas.
 - ii. Nursery areas bounded by white line and/or ropes.
 - iii. Bare areas on the left of H3 & H13 and right of H4.
 - iv. Any area or ground considered by a Referee to be abnormal.
- 3b) Immovable Obstructions
 - i. White lined areas and the immovable obstruction they tie into are treated as a single abnormal course condition.
 - ii. Floodlight units, control boxes and lightning arrestors. (Free relief for Line of Play is NOT available).
 - iii. Root bearer/rubber landscape liners (Relief is available when the Root Bearer/Black Liners physically interferes with play).
 - iv. All staked trees including supporting ropes.
 - v. Plastic turf pro mats.
 - vi. Drop Zone for Immovable Obstructions (Half Way Hut) Behind Putting Greens Garden #4. If a ball lies in the area bounded by a white lines/dot around the Half Way Hut behind Putting Green Garden Hole #4, or when the obstruction interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing and relief is required, the player may proceed under Rule 16.1 as an additional option, a Drop Zone is provided.

4. No Play Zone (Club's Signage & Landscape Area at Garden #10)

Free relief **MUST** be taken from interference by the NO PLAY ZONE under Rule 16.1f and as an additional option, a Drop Zone is provided.

5. Ball Deflected by Power Line

MLR E-11 If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line during play, **the stroke does not count**. The player **MUST** replay a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made.

6. Integral Objects

- 6a) Bunker liners in their intended position.

7. Returning of Scorecard

- 7a) A player's scorecard is officially returned to the Committee when the player has completely left the Scorecard Submission Room or demarcated area with both feet.
- 7b) MLR L-1 In the event player returns their scorecard without player or marker certification, the penalty will be 2 strokes.

8 Transportation

MLR G-6 During a round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. A player who will play or has played under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation. The player gets the general penalty for each hole during which there is a breach. A breach between two holes applies to the next hole.

9 Practice

MLR I-1.1 A player must not practise on the competition course before or between rounds.

First Breach: Penalty 2 strokes

Second Breach: DQP
