







## **LOCAL RULES**

- 1. <u>Drop Zone</u>: Hole #6 has a drop zone by the green on the left side. U.S Kids Modified Rule: Any player who hits their ball into the desert has the option of playing the ball as it lies, no penalty, or they may use the three Lateral Hazard Options: (1) go back to the original spot and drop a ball, (2) two club lengths in any direction, no closer to the hole, (3) move the ball from where it last crossed the margin as far back as they choose on a straight line from the flag stick, add one stroke penalty. Another option available, the player may use the USKG Local Rule regarding a Drop Zone on the "Opposite Side" of the Penalty Area with a TWO-STROKE penalty.
- 2. Left side of hole #12 plays lateral.
- 3. **Hole #17**: If your ball is in the penalty area by the green, no relief from fence surrounding the water hazard. If your ball is outside the penalty area and interfered by the fence from swing or stance, free relief
- 4. All water hazards at The Legacy are Lateral Water Hazards. When lines are visible, please use them. If no line present, hazard line starts where the ground slopes downward.
- 5. **Out of Bounds** defined by white stakes, roadways, and property fence lines. A ball resting against a property fence does not get free relief.
- 6. No relief from rocks or boulders that are designed to be an integral part of the course without penalty.
- 7. Any ball that crosses a boundary fence is Out of Bounds.
- 8. Do not refer to the local scorecard for Local Rules.
- 9. If you need assistance for a ruling, please call 702-883-9197 or 619-829-9675. If no answer, play a second ball, we will rule at the scoring table. **DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE:** If a competitor is doubtful of their rights or the correct procedure during the play of a hole, they may without penalty, complete the hole with two balls. After the doubtful situation has arisen and before taking further action, the competitor must announce to their marker or a fellow competitor their intention to play two balls and which ball they wish to count if the rules permit. If failing to do so, the provisions of Rule 20.1c apply. The competitor must report the facts of the situation to the Committee before returning their score card. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
