Course: Mid Pines

Age Groups: Boys 15-18: USKG Tee 7

Boys 13-14: USKG Tee 6

Tee times start: Tee time is listed on your scorecard and cart sign.

Lunch: Provided to all participants during their round.

Format: Modified Scramble – Only parents will tee off on holes highlighted in yellow and only kids will tee off on holes highlighted in green. Competitors will scramble for the remainder of the hole. Both players will tee off on all holes not highlighted and select the best tee shot.

Scorecards: Scorecards will be distributed at the starting tee. Team score will be recorded on each scorecard. You will keep your competitor’s score. Scores will be verbally agreed upon and totaled following your round at the scoring table. There will be no exchanging of scorecards. Please report the scoring area immediately after completion of play.

Tees: All players will play from U.S. Kids Golf Tee Markers

Awards: Trophies will be presented to 1st and 2nd place in each age group. There will be no awards presentation on site, as players are asked to leave the facility following the round. Winners will be announced online and trophies will be available for pickup at the Pinehurst Resort. We will email winners with pickup information.

Tiebreaker: U.S. Kids Golf Scorecard Playoff will be used to break ties for all awards. Winner will be determined on the basis of the team score on the last nine holes, last six holes, last three holes and finally the last hole of the competition course. If the teams are still tied, continue backwards from the last hole until a winner is determined. (The “last nine holes, last six holes, etc.” is considered to be 10-18, 13-18, etc.)

Players must place their ball within one club length of the shot selected, no nearer to the hole. Players' ball must remain in the same condition as the shot selected, i.e. fairway, rough, or sand. Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and Decisions, the US Kids Golf Foundation Rules and Regulations, and by the following Local Rules:

DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE: Only members of the Rules Committee are authorized to render a Rules Decision. If in doubt as to the correct procedure, and a member of the Rules Committee is not present, play a second ball under Rule 20-1 and report the facts to the Committee even if the scores are the same with both balls. Failure to do so shall result in disqualification.

FLAGSTICK: At this time, the flagstick is fixed in the hole and MUST NOT be deliberately touched or removed by any player or caddie. The first offense constitutes a warning. A two-shot penalty will be given for each subsequent offense.

WASTE AREAS: There are no bunkers on the golf course. All sandy areas are waste areas and are played as "through the green".

OUT OF BOUNDS: Out of bounds is defined by inside points of white stakes at ground level; and by the inside edges of the parking lot and driveway left of #18 adjacent to the conference center.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas defined by white lines. Also, French drains, which are filled with rocks or stones.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: 1) Artificially surfaced paths and birdhouses on poles are deemed obstructions. 2) All sand paths are deemed integral parts of the course and no free relief is provided. 3) Any railroad ties boarding cart paths or white lined areas tying into roads or obstructions are deemed to be part of the same obstruction. 4) Erosion control bales and stakes.

ROADS AND PATHS: Artificially surfaced paths are deemed obstructions. All other paths are deemed integral parts of the course. Any white lined areas tying into roads or paths are deemed to be part of the same cart path obstruction. Wood pilings and large rocks (not small stones) adjacent to artificially surfaced cart paths are deemed to be part of the same obstruction.
