Pre-Event Practise Rounds

Practice Ground Usage

The Practice Ground is located just outside the main entrance to the estate. To obtain practise ball prior to the competition week please speak to the admin staff or Pro Shop Team.

The area consists of a 300-metre range off grass tees, a short game chipping area and a practise bunker.

Tokens for practice balls may be purchased from the shop (50 balls per basket @ £4.50 or a multi buy of 5 for £20.00). There is limited parking outside the practise area however it is only a short walk from the main carpark.

During the week of Competition the practice ground opening hours will be:

Monday	29 th May	- 6.30am to 6pm
Tuesday	30 th May	- 6.30am to 6pm
Wednesday	31 st May	- 6.30am to 6pm
Thursday	1 st June	- 6.30 am to 2 pm

During this week we will have staff/volunteers stationed in the practise area who will dispense balls, but they must be pre-paid in the administration office.

Important: No practice chipping is allowed on the putting green next to the Professional Shop.

Changing Facilities

We have limited changing facilities which include lockers. Showers are available but players must bring own towels, the wearing of soft spikes is not permitted in the clubhouse except in the locker room. All property is left at the owners' own risk.

Catering Facilities

The bar and restaurant are on the first floor of the club house where you can relax and take in the great views.

From Monday, 29th May, there will be full catering facilities from 6.30am.

Standard of Dress

On the Course and in the Clubhouse:

Visitors are expected to be smartly dressed both on the course and in the clubhouse. Broadly speaking there is a single standard for all parts of the clubhouse and what is suitable for the course is suitable for the clubhouse other than golf shoes, the exception to this is golf headwear which isn't permitted to be worn in the clubhouse.

Shirts should have sleeves and collars, though round necked shirts designed specifically for golf are acceptable. Shirts should be tucked in.

Trousers and shorts should be tailored; Blue denim jeans are not acceptable.

Socks worn with shorts should be golf, sports or trainer socks.

Professional's Shop

Yardage books are available from the Professional's shop at a cost of £5. The shop has a comprehensive stock of leading brand clothing and equipment.

Buggies

No buggies are available during the event week.

Push/Pull Trolleys

These can be hired via the pro shop. £5.00 per round.

Mobile Phones

The use of mobile phones is prohibited on the Course (other than in the case of an emergency). Mobile phones may be kept on silent in the Clubhouse to allow use of Wi-Fi.

Liability

Visitors, their vehicles and equipment are on Club property at their own risk and the Club has no liability. The Club has the right to refuse entry or the removal of a visitor at its absolute discretion.

Car Parking

Parking is available at the Club. Please do not leave valuables in your car or unattended around the Club
