

Rules Disputes

- Rule 20.1: If a competitor is doubtful of his rights or the correct procedure during play of a hole, the player may, without penalty, complete the hole with two balls or call the rules hotline.
- If a player believes a fellow competitor's actions are not in accordance with the Rules of Golf, the player should immediately bring it to the attention of the fellow competitor or rules official. If the players are unsure how to proceed and cannot locate a Rules Official, they should proceed under Rule 20.1.
- All rules questions and disputes <u>must be handled</u> and resolved by a Rules Official or Member of the Tournament Committee prior to all players leaving the scoring tent.
- Rules issues arising after scoring has been completed are handled at the discretion of the Rules Committee.
