



Final Round Tee Time Plan – Single Tee Start

Single Tee Start – Two Waves – Lead Groups in First Wave

Final Round Pairing Plan: In the Final Round, the top 50% of the field, and ties (Wave A), will tee off first, followed by the remainder of the field (Wave B).

Final Round Inclement Weather Policy: If inclement weather forces us to shorten play, the tournament will be considered complete if all players in Wave 1 complete a 9 or 18-hole stipulated round in accordance with the World Championship Rules & Regulations. All players in Wave B must be able to finish all holes for Wave B's Final Round scores to count towards the event.
