



Final Round Tee Time Plan – Single Tee Start

Single Tee Start – Two Flights – Lead Groups in First Flight

Final Round Pairing Plan: For the Final Round, the top 50% of the field, and ties (Flight A), will tee off first, followed by the remainder of the field (Flight B).

Final Round Inclement Weather Policy: If inclement weather forces us to shorten play, the tournament will be considered complete if all players in Flight A complete a stipulated round (9 or 18 holes for 18-hole players) in accordance with the World Championship Rules & Regulations. All players in Flight B must finish all holes for Flight B's Final Round scores to count towards the event. If the Championship is not played to completion, then Flight A and Flight B are considered separate tournaments. The goal of the Final Round pairing plan is to identify a champion after three complete rounds. The policy is in place should afternoon storms, which frequently occur this time of year, force incompleteness of the final round.

Note: For Girls 13 and Girls 14 at Pine Needles, the Girls 13 and Girls 14 A Flights will go off first on Saturday morning, followed by the Girls 13 and Girls 14 B Flights.
