

U.S. KIDS VENICE OPEN 17-19 August 2025



The following Terms of Competition and Local Rules and notes published by the Committee, together with USKIDS International Championship Rules and Regulation, will apply to VENICE OPEN 2025 – (boys 13-18 and girls 13-18 at Golf Frassanelle) (boys 9-12 and girls 10-12 at Golf della Montecchia) – and played in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved by the R&A Rules Limited. For the full text of the Local Rules referenced below, please refer to the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf effective from January 2023 and the Clarifications updated quarterly by the R&A.

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of the Local Rules is the General Penalty

LOCAL RULES

1. PREFERRED LIES

When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it form this relief area:

- Reference Point: spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area measured from Reference Point: within the length of one scorecard length from the Reference Point.
- Limits on Location of Re lief Area: must not be nearer to the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area. In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the Ball and use the procedure for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2h(2) and 14.2e

Penalty for playing ball from a wrong place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty under Rule 14.7a.

2. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2)

a) A ball is out of bounds when it is beyond any wall defining a boundary.

ONLY for MONTECCHIA:

- a. INTERNAL OUT OF BOUNDS (*red course*): When playing hole #7/16 the right side up to about 100 meters from the green, defined by white/green stakes, is out of bounds. The white/green stakes are objects that define the limit during the game of hole 7/16; for all other hole these stakes are immovable obstractions.
- b. INTERNAL OUT OF BOUNDS (*green course*): When playing hole #9/18 a ball is out of bounds if the lie on or is beyond the white/red stakes and broken white line on hole 1/10; when playing hole #1/10 red/white stakes on the right rough defines the penalty area.
- c. The outer edge of the asphalt road (identified with white stakes): on the right of hole 9 (white course), behind the greens of hole 9 (white course) and 9 (red course), behind the teeing area of hole 1(white course) and 1 (red course), defines the out of bounds.

3. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)

ONLY for FRASSANELLE:

- **Dropping Zones for Penalty Areas**: as the hole #15 Dropping Zone is marked for a penalty area, it is an additional option under penalty of one stroke. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3, meaning that a ball must be dropped in and come to rest in the relief area.
- **Hole #12:** Red Penalty Area on the right side is extended to infinity.

ONLY for MONTECCHIA:

• **Dropping Zones for Penalty Areas:** at the hole #2(*red course*) and #8 (*red course*) dropping zone is marked for a penalty area, it is additional option under penalty of one stroke. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3, meaning that a ball must be dropped in and came to rest in the relief area.

4. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (RULE 16.1)

a) Ground Under Repair

- 1. All areas bounded by white lines.
- 2. Seams of Cut Turf: Model Local Rule F-7 is in effect.
- 3. French drains (stone-filled drainage ditches).
- 4. Erosions in bunker caused by water. Relief available for lie of the ball ONLY.
- Damages created by wild boar.
- 6. Cracks in earth.

b) Immovable Obstructions

- 1. White lined areas and the immovable obstruction they tie into, are treated as a single abnormal course condition.
- Landscaped garden areas (and everything growing in them) that are completely surrounded by an immovable obstruction, are treated as a single abnormal course condition.
- 3. All roads and paths.
- 4. Where areas of damaged ground are right next to artificially surfaced road or path or other identified obstruction they are treated as a single abnormal course condition when taking relief under RULE 16.1: Model Local Rule F-3.2 is in effect.

5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN

• Model Local Rule F-5.2 is in effect but is modified as follows: For a ball in general area, relief is allowed only when both the ball and the immovable obstruction lie in an area cut to fairway height or less.

6. INTEGRAL OBJECTS

- 1. Wires, cables, wrapping or other objects when closely attached to trees or other permanent objects.
- 2. Artificial retaining walls and pilings when located within penalty areas.
- 3. Any closed gate attached to a boundary object.
- 4. ONLY FOR FRASSANELLE: Rocks and Stones wall located between holes #7 and #8.

7. PERMANENT OVERHEAD POWER LINE

• Model Local Rule E-11is in effect but only if it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball strikes a power line in bounds and not the supporting pole; the stroke is cancelled and must be replayed (see Rule 14.6). If the plyer does not replay the stroke, she gets the general penalty and the stroke counts, but the player has not played from a wrong place. If the player replays the stroke but does so from a wrong place, she gets the general penalty under Rule 14.7.

8. DISQUALIFICATION MODIFIFICATION

The U.S. Kids Golf Disqualification Policy (DPQ) is NOT applied for rankings (WAGR, Order of Merit, Italian Rankings)

9. TRANSPORTATION POLICY

Model Local Rule G-6 is in effect and is modified in this way: "During a round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form
of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. (A player taking s stroke and distance
penalty is always authorized)."

Penalty for breach of this Local Rule: General Penalty for each hole during which there is a breach, maximum penalty for round: Four strokes. A breach between holes applies to the next hole.

10. PRACTICE (RULE 5)

 Practice before or between rounds in Stroke Play (Rule 5.2b): Rule 5.2b is modified in this way: A player must not practice on the competition course before or between rounds.

Penalty for breach of Rule 5.2: See penalty statement in Rule 5.2.

11. SCORECARD RESPONSIBILITIES

• Rule 3.3b(2) is modified in this way:

If player returns a scorecard without the hole scores being certified either by the player, the marker or both, the player gets the general penalty (two penalty strokes). The penalty applies to the last hole of the player's round.
