



Volunteer Position Descriptions

Player Registration

The duties of a registration volunteer include: checking in players, distributing tee gifts and event materials, verifying dates of birth, and/or other various tasks.

Pace of Play

Each volunteer will record the finishing times of the groups as they pass through checkpoint holes to make sure they are on pace. A Pace of Play volunteer will be stationed at the greens of Holes #4, 9, 13 or 18. They will alert Tournament Staff and Rules Officials of any bad pace times. Pace of Play volunteers will communicate with Tournament Staff only and are not required to interact with players or caddies

Scorers

Scorers will be responsible for facilitating the scoring procedures set by U.S. Kids Golf. Scoring volunteers will be located at either Hole #9 or #18 and must help the participants turn in the official scorecards.

Shuttle Drivers

Shuttle drivers will be responsible for safely transporting players and caddies at designated areas on the golf course. A valid driver's license is required for this position.

Spotter

Spotters will be positioned in various locations on the course to help watch for golf balls and/or let a group know when the fairway has cleared.

Supply

Water Supply volunteers are responsible for helping to keep players and caddies hydrated. Volunteers will be stationed at the tee box of Holes #4 and #13, distributing water bottles. Some volunteers will be tasked with making sure those volunteers stay adequately stocked with water. We'll also have drinking coolers on Holes #1 and #10 (where applicable), to keep filled and iced.

Volunteer Control

Volunteers will be stationed in an office space and are responsible for checking in volunteers and distributing their materials. Volunteer Control works closely with the Course Captain. Control volunteers will also collect materials and radios once volunteers return following their shifts.
