

Final Round Tee Time Plan – Double Tee Start

Double Tee Start - Two Waves - Lead Groups in 1st Wave

Final Round Pairing Plan: In the Final Round, the top 50% of the field, and ties (Wave 1), will tee off first, followed by the remainder of the field (Wave 2).

Final Round Inclement Weather Policy: If inclement weather forces us to shorten play, the tournament will be considered complete if all players in Wave 1 complete a 9 or 18-hole stipulated round in accordance with the World Championships Hard Card. All players in Wave 2 must be able to finish all holes for Wave 2's Final Round scores to count towards the event.
