



Final Round Tee Time Plan – Single Tee Start

Single Tee Start – Two Flights – Lead Groups in First Flight

Final Round Pairing Plan: For the Final Round, the top 50% of the field, and ties (Flight A), will tee off first, followed by the remainder of the field (Flight B).

Final Round Inclement Weather Policy: If inclement weather forces us to shorten play, the tournament will be considered complete if all players in Flight A complete a stipulated round (5 or 9 holes for 9-hole players, 9 or 18 holes for 18-hole players) in accordance with the World Championship Rules & Regulations. All players in Flight B must finish all holes for Flight B's Final Round scores to count towards the event. If the Championship is not played to completion, then Flight A and Flight B are considered separate tournaments. The goal of the Final Round pairing plan is to identify a champion after three complete rounds. The policy is in place should afternoon storms, which frequently occur this time of year, force incompletion of the final round.

Age Groups with Single Tee Starts

Boys 6 & Under, Boys 7, Boys 8, Boys 9, Girls 7 & Under, Girls 8, Girls 9, Girls 10, Girls 11, Girls 12

Note: On the Longleaf Front Nine, the Girls 9 and Girls 7 & Under A Flights will go off first on Saturday morning, followed by the B Flights. On the Back Nine, Girls 8 and Boys 6 & Under A Flights will go off first on Saturday morning, followed by B Flights.
