

\*\*The top 20 Boys 12 and top 12 Girls 12 are selected for the Van Horn cup teams after the second round. If they are ties, below is how we will break to the ties in the age groups.

Ties will be decided by using the U.S. Kids Golf Scorecard Playoff policy as follows: Ties for team positions will be broken by the best score on the second round. If the tying players have the same score on the second round, the winner will be determined on the basis of the best score on the final nine holes of competition. If the tying players have the same score for the final nine, the winner will be determined on the basis of the final six holes, final three holes and lastly the 18th hole of the final round. If the players are still tied, continue backwards from the final hole of competition until a winner is determined. For 18-hole players, the "final nine holes, final six holes, etc." is considered to be holes 10-18, 13-18, etc.
