

U.S. Kids Golf Families,

We will be monitoring Sunday's weather very closely. Ultimately, we play an outdoor sport and the elements will always be a part of competition. Our goal is to complete as much golf as reasonably possible. Play will only be delayed/suspended in the case of lightning, prolonged heavy rain, or if the course becomes unplayable.

Stipulated Rounds

When it becomes necessary to shorten an event (due to weather, course conditions, etc.), final results will be based on stipulated rounds completed by the players.

- In 9-hole Age Groups, all players in the age group would need to complete at least 5-holes for Round 2 scores to count. Based on number of holes completed, it will either be a 9, 14, or 18-hole event.
- In 18-hole Age Groups, all players in the age group would need to complete at least 9 holes for Round 2 scores to count. Based on number of holes completed, it will either be an 18, 27, or 36-hole event.

Lift Clean & Place

All courses will be playing under lift, clean and place procedures in Round 2.

A ball lying on a closely mown area in the general area (your own fairway/fringe) may be lifted and cleaned. Before lifting the ball, the player should mark its position. Having lifted the ball, the player must place it on a spot within 1 club-length and no closer to the hole than where it originally lay, that is not in a penalty area or on a putting green. **A player may place the ball only once, and it is in play once placed and at rest.** Caddies have authorization to mark, lift, clean and place the ball for the player.

Rankings

AJGA and Junior Golf Scoreboard will still accept results in a multi-day event for each eligible Age Group that completes at least 18 holes.

Priority Status

Age Groups that do not complete two full rounds will be awarded Priority Status by Order of Finish. (1st – Level 13, 2nd – Level 12, 3rd – Level 11, 4th – Level 10, 5th – Level 9). For Age Groups with 20 or more players, the remaining players in the Top 50% of the field will receive Level 8.

Awards

In the case of a shortened event, trophies will still be presented to each Age Group. Once scores are deemed final, the Top Five & Ties will receive trophies. Awards will be presented at your assigned golf course at a location to be determined (subject to change based on weather).
