

LIFT, CLEAN & PLACE PROCEDURES

A ball lying on a closely mown area (your own fairway) in the general area may be lifted and cleaned. Before lifting the ball, the player should mark its position. Having lifted the ball, the player must place it on a spot within 1 club-length and no closer to the hole than where it originally lay, that is not in a penalty area or on a putting green. A player may place the ball only once, and it is in play once placed and at rest.

Caddies have authorization to mark, lift, clean and place the ball for the player. Please be very mindful of pace of play when taking relief. Players still are only allotted 40 seconds per shot. Relief procedures count toward that time frame.
